Parking: All persons in a vehicle entering the band parking area must show a games pass or purchase one before the vehicle will be allowed to park.

Rules:

1. EUSPBA rules will govern all events.
2. Competitors must be a member of the EUSPBA or other Piping Association.
3. Drum Pad & Practice Chanter are unsanctioned events. EUSPBA membership is not required.
4. Each drumming competitor must furnish their own accompanist.
5. Solo Competitors in Grades 3 and above and Pipe Bands must be in appropriate Highland Dress, including headgear and no medals.
6. Competitors must be ready when called to compete or be disqualified.
7. Decisions by the Director, Stewards and Judges are final.
