NEW THIS YEAR: We plan to announce Piper and Drummer of the Day for each grade (trophies) during closing ceremony. If you need to leave before closing ceremony please check with the registration table.

Parking: All persons in a vehicle entering the band parking area must show games pass or purchase one before the vehicle will be allowed to park.

Comments:

1. EUSPBA rules will govern all events.
2. Competitors must be a member of the EUSPBA or other Piping Association for points to be awarded.
3. Drum Pad & Practice Chanter are unsanctioned events. EUSPBA membership is not required.
4. 50+ Event, Open Musical Composition are unsanctioned events. EUSPBA membership is not required.
5. Each drumming competitor must furnish his/her own accompanist.
6. Solo Competitors in Grades 4 and above and Pipe Bands must be in appropriate Highland Dress, including headgear and no medals.
7. Competitors must be ready when called to compete or be disqualified; however, the stewards will work with you if conflicts.
8. Decisions by the Director, Stewards and Judges are final.
